

Dear Sister Bro & Family

Brood Mine

Your welcome letter received last week and would have answered sooner but I was in pretty bad shape from Friday until Monday but I am feeling a little better again. Last July I had a soreness under my heart and a congestion of the lower lungs and was coughing blood which I have found since was chronic Bronchitis I was not sick just miserable so I went to the doctors and they examined me and sent me for an Xray which showed my lungs in good shape but when I asked our doctors where the blood was ^{coming from} they started to examine my nose and put it off as nothing so it kept getting worse until I started having severe pains in my arms & through my chest so on the 16 of Nov I had to go in for my annual Xray and Mr Morgan told the doctors I had Pleurisy and I have been of work since 18 of Nov and I think I am done working as my heart is in bad shape. Brood Mine Proper is about three miles from Sudbury and there are 11 houses there there was some

Talk of building some houses over there this spring but there has never been any thing official yet

There is only one Studio in Sudbury that I know of and he is a Finn Kilmi he is a cripple but I never thought much of any of his work I have seen Copper Cliff is about $4\frac{1}{2}$ miles from Sudbury The Smelter and head office is there.

There are a lot of men work at Copper Cliff and board in Sudbury and travel on the street railway or Taxi

Northington is 28 miles from Sudbury I have not heard from Robbie since New Years He & Clara were out here when he was home he works in the Lake Shore Mine at Kirkland Lake but he never writes and I very seldom go to his place when he is not home As I have not much use for her.

There are 2200 men working here and they all live in Sudbury they go by bus Taxi and walk There are about 3 to 1 of Foreigners mostly Polacks and Southern Europeans There are some Finns and a few Norwegians This is a good place for Hockey Foot Ball & Base Ball Players

They get good jobs and good money
The most of the cub wolves are
working here.

There is a Refinery at Copper l'if
and all their men live in Sudbury
I have not heard from John or saw
any of them since I was up there
two years ago I was up there.

Viola is living in Cobalt and
she keeps Gordon & Alice she is
married to a fellow Carl Hutt
He did not see Gordon or Alice
they were out well Bee I guess
this is all for this time so
will say Adieu
