I was in hopes I could get a new car next spring but if I don't get to work that will be all off.

I've also received the pictures they are some bunch of boys & girls you have we have four two boys & two girls My Lloyd Helen & Wilma our came a boy then Helen the Lloyd and Wilma will be fine in Jan.
